

OUR REACH


What would you like young women like yourself to know about Inspire Her Afrika?

Smart Budget Buddy Expense Tracker

The Smart Budget Buddy is an intuitive, spreadsheet-based expense tracker designed to help individuals manage their daily finances while fostering consistent saving habits.

The tool addresses two common challenges: difficulty in tracking daily expenses and failure to save regularly. The unique "Save as You Spend" feature encourages users to allocate a small portion of their expenditure toward savings each time they log an expense.

Empowering kids through story telling




